- Student must attend a Char-Em ISD school (All students are eligible including children of employees
- Applicants can not ask for 100% funding
- Student has exhibited a desire to rise to the challenge of new experiences
- Student has a strong likelihood of improved self-image as the result of the camp experience
- The camp experience will:
 - ⇒ Provide the student with a sense of success and accomplishment
 - ⇒ Offer the opportunity to potentially develop new interests and skills
 - ⇒ Enhance personal skill and character development that can carry over into other areas of the student's life
- Student has demonstrated some capacity to succeed in the camp experience
- Student must be between the ages of 10-18 years
